2003 Survey of Departmental Conflicts Sorted by Nature of Conflict

Potential Overlaps

By sorting the 2003 survey by "nature of dispute," the following significant overlaps were found. Please let Michele Straube (583-6362, mstraube@mindspring.com) know if you see cross-agency ADR opportunities in any of these overlaps.

- employee issues (many different types of issues, many agencies) -- most of which can be handled through the CSRB pilot
- GRAMA requests (Ag&Food, DOC, GO/Criminal & Juv. Justice Comm., PSC, DAS/risk mgt)
- BCI (DHS, DPS)
- consumer complaints (various agencies) -- ombuds opportunities ?
- discrimination / harassment / retaliation (DEQ, DHRM, DWS, UALD, UT Housing) -- if the issues are similar, could some of the other agencies' disputes be routed through UALD?
- eminent domain (DNR / SITLA) -- if the issues are similar, could some of the SITLA disputes be routed through Craig Call ?
- jurisdiction disputes -- inter- and intra-agency disputes
- licensing denials (Ag&Food, DABC, DHS, DOC/Pete Suazo, DOPL, DOC/Securities, Insurance, DNR/Wildlife, DOC/Consumer Protection, DOC/Real Estate, DPS/BCI, DPS/drivers license, DPS/fire marshals, DPS/Post, DPS/UHP, Health)
- rulemaking -- if just one agency wanted to develop a rule using a collaborative process, that could be an excellent pilot
