TC-8453C Instructions

This form is to be filed as an attachment to your Utah corporation (TC-20) or Utah S corporation (TC-20S) return as the signature document for the electronic submission of the return.

How to File

File form TC-8453C with the corporation's electronically filed return. Use a scanner to create a Portable Document File (PDF) of the completed form. Your tax preparation software will allow you to transmit this PDF file with the return.

Specific Instructions

Part 1

The corporation name, EIN and tax return information must match the entries on the Utah corporation return.

Part 2

A corporate officer authorized to sign the corporation's tax return must sign TC-8453C. A return is not acceptable and any refund will be denied unless there is an authorized signature on the form.

If checking the Paid Preparer Authorization box, see the disclaimer information in the "Paid Preparer Information" box, right.

Part 3

A paid preparer must sign form TC-8453C in the space designated Paid Preparer's Section, and complete the firm name, address, SSN or PTIN, and the firm's federal employer identification number.

***Paid Preparer Authorization**

Checking this box authorizes the Tax Commission to discuss the return with the paid preparer. The Tax Commission may call the paid preparer to answer any questions that may arise during the processing of the return.

This authorization applies only to the individual whose signature appears in the Paid Preparer Section of this form. It does not apply to the firm, if any, shown in that section.

Checking this box also authorizes the paid preparer to:

- Give the Tax Commission any information that is missing from the return,
- Call the Tax Commission for information about the processing of the return or the status of any refund or payment(s), and
- Respond to certain Tax Commission notices about math errors, offsets, and return preparation.

The corporation is not authorizing the preparer to receive any refund, bind the entity to anything (including any additional tax liability), or otherwise represent the entity before the Tax Commission. If the corporation wants to expand the preparer's authorization, complete and submit to the Tax Commission form TC-737, Power of Attorney and Declaration of Representative. Form TC-737 is available on our website at tax.utah.gov/forms.

The authorization will automatically end no later than the due date (without regard to extensions) for filing the entity's 2008 tax return. If you wish to revoke the authorization before it ends, submit your request in writing to the Utah State Tax Commission, attention Taxpayer Services, 210 N 1950 W, SLC, UT 84134.
