STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Petitioner brings this appeal from the decision of the County Board of Equalization. This matter was scheduled for an Initial Hearing pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Ann. Sec. 59-1-502.5, on June 16, 2009. Just prior to the scheduled time the parties telephoned the Administrative Law Judge and reported that they had reached a settlement agreement regarding the value.

Petitioner (the "Property Owner") had filed an appeal of the assessed value as established for the subject property by the Salt Lake County Board of Equalization, as of the lien date January 1, 2008. The County Assessor had set the value at \$\$\$\$\$ and the County Board of Equalization sustained the value. The Property Owner requested that the value be lowered to \$\$\$\$\$.
