- VI. **Approve submission of proposed rule amendments to the Office of Administrative Rules for publication in *Utah State Bulletin***

1. R884-24P-53. 2021 Valuation Guides for Valuation of Land Subject to the Farmland Assessment Act Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-2-515.

Commissioner Rockwell: The following proposed rule amendments are for the Commission to consider and submit for publication to the Office of Administrative Rules. The rules will be published in the *Utah State Bulletin* on October 15, 2021 and the public comment period will end on November 15, 2021.

1. R884-24P-53. 2021 Valuation Guides for Valuation of Land Subject to the Farmland Assessment Act Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-2-515. This amendment is made annually to update the agricultural productive values to be applied by county assessors to land qualifying for valuation and assessment under the Farmland Assessment Act (FAA). These values are recommended to the Commission by the State Farmland Evaluation Advisory Committee, which meets under the authority of Section 59-2-514

Commissioner Rockwell moved to submit the proposed rule amendment to Rule 884-24P-53. 2021 Valuation Guides for Valuation of Land Subject to the Farmland Assessment Act Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-2-515, to the Office of Administrative Rules for publication in the Utah State Bulletin.
