Jury convicts Pleasant Grove man on 15 counts of tax evasion

Robin Dale Kartchner of Pleasant Grove, Utah, has been convicted of 15 felony counts of tax evasion for failing to submit proper tax returns and for intent to avoid payment of taxes as long ago as 2007.

The case was prosecuted by the Utah Attorney General's Office and investigated by the Criminal Investigation Unit of the Utah State Tax Commission.

Utah State Tax Commission investigators testified that Kartchner, 69, has failed to file proper income tax returns by claiming his income was \$0 for several years. But his employer reported wages ranging from \$77,013 to \$112,886.

Kartchner faces sentencing November 25, 2019. He could serve from one-to-15 years in prison.
