Amateur Radio	Provide a copy of a current FCC license with assigned call numbers.	\$21
Autism Awareness	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of autism awareness programs.	\$91
Boy Scouts	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Boy Scouts of America.	\$91
Boys and Girls Club	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to Boys and Girls Club.	\$91
Cancer Research	Annual contribution of at least \$35 must be made in support of cancer research.	\$101
Children's Issues	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Guardian Ad Litem organization and the Children's Museum of Utah.	\$91
Collegiate	Annual contribution in support of the selected school is required. The minimum annual contribution is: \$25 for the Dixie State University, LDS Business College, Salt Lake Community College, Snow College, Southern Utah University, Utah State University, Utah Valley University, Weber State University, or Western Governor's University.	\$91

Civil Air Patrol Recognition Plate	Recognizes and commemorates the Utah Wing of the Civil Air Patrol. This plate is available to any person making the request.	\$66
Disabled Person	Provide a complete form TC-842, Disabled Person and Physician Disability Certification.	\$66
Disabled Veteran	Provide a letter from the Utah Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs or United States Military entity, certifying the veteran's disabled status. This plate does not qualify for parking in a disabled parking space.	\$66
Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)	Requires a certificate of current EMT training.	\$66
Farm Truck	This plate may be issued to trucks used exclusively to transport farm products or supplies.	\$66
Firefighter	Annual contribution of at least \$15 must be made to the Firefighter Support Fund. Provide any one of the following: evidence of current membership in the Utah Firefighter's Association; an official identification card issued by a firefighting entity identifying the applicant as an employee or volunteer; or a letter on letterhead from a firefighting entity or from the county/municipality in which the firefighting entity is located, identifying the applicant as an employee, retired employee or volunteer of the firefighting entity.	\$81
Former Prisoner of War (POW)	Provide a copy of Form DD214 or a Statement of Service from the Department of Veterans' Affairs.	\$66
Gold Star	Provide a document showing classification of death as listed by the U. S. Secretary of Defense, a casualty report, a telegram from the U. S. Secretary of Defense, or another document that verifies the applicant is a recipient of the Gold Star award.	\$66
Honoring Heroes	Annual contribution of at least \$35 must be made to the Public Safety Honoring Heroes foundation.	\$101
Humanitarian Service	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of various Utah humanitarian service organizations.	\$91
National Guard	Provide copy of military photo ID.	\$66
No More Homeless Pets	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of No More Homeless Pets in Utah.	\$91
Pearl Harbor Survivor	Provide a copy of a membership card issued by the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association.	\$66

Search and Rescue Radio	Provide documentation verifying call numbers from the county sheriff and a required item from the Search and Rescue plate as shown above.	\$21
Share the Road	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Share the Road Bicycle Support Fund.	\$91
Snowmobiler	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of snowmobile safety education programs. No annual contribution is required.	\$91
Soil Conservation	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of agricultural education programs. No annual contribution is required.	\$91
Special Interest	Vehicle must be 20 years old or older or must meet the requirements in Utah Code §41-1a-102(70). Provide a Statement of Facts (TC-569D) detailing the reason why your vehicle meets these requirements.	\$66
Utah Jazz	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the National Professional Men's Basketball Team support of women and children issues.	\$91
Utah Housing Opportunity (Realtor)	Annual contribution of at least \$30 must be made in support of affordable housing programs. Provide proof of membership in a trade organization for real estate licensees which has more than 15,000 Utah members.	\$96
Veterans	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Utah Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs. An annual contribution of \$10 must be made thereafter. Applicant may select the Air Force, American Legion, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, or Navy plate.	\$91
Veteran Combat Theater	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Utah Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs. An annual contribution of \$10 must be made thereafter. Applicant may select the Army Combat Infantry Badge, Army Combat Action Badge, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or the Marine & Navy Combat Action Ribbon. Must obtain proof of qualification for the campaign or combat theater award requested from the Utah Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs.	\$91
Vintage	Vehicle must be at least 30 years old and not driven for general daily transportation.	\$66
Wildlife	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of wildlife and wildlife habitat preservation. Applicant may select the Kestrel, Elk, Trout, or Mule Deer plate.	\$91
Women's Suffrage	Recognizes and commemorates women's suffrage. This plate is available to any person making the request.	\$66
Zion National Park	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of Zion National Park preservation.	\$91

All plates, except Amateur Radio, Search and Rescue Radio, and Purple Heart, require payment of an additional \$10 fee when renewing for the next registration year. Any personalized plate that has not been renewed within six months of its expiration date will be forfeited.
