Dear Taxpayer:

The Auditing Division has reviewed your Sales Tax, Municipal Telecommunications License Tax (Municipal Telecom Tax), and Emergency Telephone Fee (E-911 Fee) returns. This review revealed possible problems and inconsistencies in the amount of your reported tax liabilities. We want to inform you of these issues and assist you in complying with your reporting responsibilities.

What you should do

Enclosed are instructions and worksheets outlining the reporting periods and questions we have regarding the returns you have filed. Please provide the requested information by **August 20, 2016**, in the envelope provided.

If the information requested is not received, your return will be subject to the 10% failure to file penalty. The penalty for failure to file a tax return includes a tax return that does not contain information necessary for the commission to make a correct distribution of tax revenues. Filing an incorrect return meets this penalty criterion. To avoid additional liabilities, the requested information must be received by **August 20, 2016**.
